

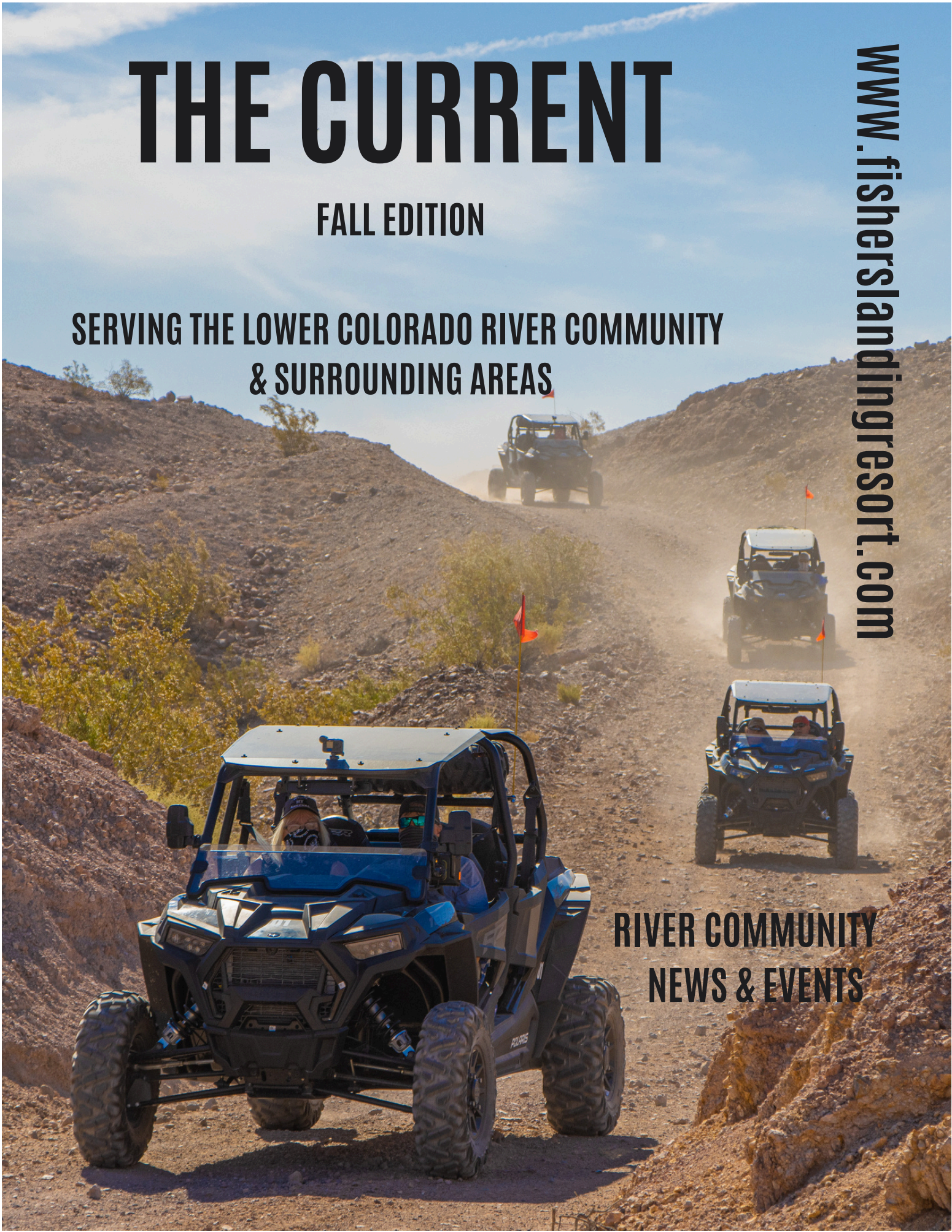

## ***RIDE SMART, RIDE SAFE: OFF-ROAD VEHICLE SAFETY***

***THE YUMA COUNTY SHERIFF'S OFFICE WOULD LIKE TO REMIND MARTINEZ LAKE RESIDENTS & VISITORS OF THE RESPONSIBILITY THAT COMES WITH OPERATING OFF-ROAD VEHICLES (OHVS).***

***THE FOLLOWING ARE COMMON OHV VIOLATIONS DEPUTIES ENCOUNTER AND CITE FOR IN YOUR AREA:  
HELMETS ARE REQUIRED FOR RIDERS AND PASSENGERS UNDER 18 YEARS OF AGE. ENSURE THEY ARE WEARING A PROTECTIVE HELMET THAT IS PROPERLY FITTED AND FASTENED, THAT IS DESIGNED FOR MOTORIZED VEHICLE USE AND THAT HAS A MINIMUM UNITED STATES DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION SAFETY RATING (A.R.S. 28-1179B).  
ADULTS ARE ALSO STRONGLY ENCOURAGED TO WEAR A HELMET TO PREVENT SERIOUS HEAD INJURIES.***

### ***LEGAL LIGHTS.***

- FRONT: ONLY WHITE OR AMBER LIGHTS ALLOWED. 28-947.B (769 )***
- REAR: ONLY RED, YELLOW, OR AMBER LIGHTS ALLOWED. 28-931.C (769 )***
- FLASHING LIGHTS: VEHICLE MUST NOT BE IN MOTION. 28-947.C***

### ***REQUIRED EQUIPMENT.***

- EYE PROTECTION IS REQUIRED IF THERE'S NO WINDSHIELD. 28-964A***
- CHILD SAFETY SEATS/BOOSTERS APPLY IN OHVS JUST LIKE IN CARS. 28-907.A***

### ***OHV SAFE OPERATION.***

- NO DOUBLING UP UNLESS THE VEHICLE WAS BUILT FOR PASSENGERS. 28-892C***

***EXTRA SAFETY TIPS: STAY ON DESIGNATED TRAILS, RIDE SOBER AND KEEP YOUR SPEED SAFE FOR THE TERRAIN. ALWAYS SUPERVISE YOUNG RIDERS AND LET SOMEONE KNOW WHERE YOU'RE GOING. WEAR GLOVES, BOOTS, AND PROTECTIVE CLOTHING.***

***BRING WATER, A FIRST-AID KIT, AND A WAY TO CALL FOR HELP.***

***--- BOTTOM LINE: KNOW THE LAWS, GEAR UP, AND BE RESPONSIBLE SO EVERY RIDE ENDS SAFELY.***

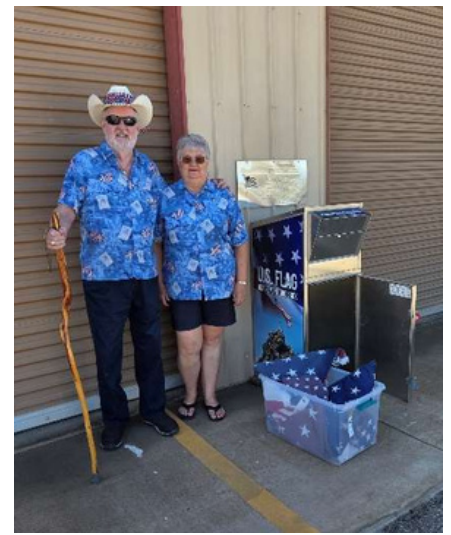

A stronger plan means we can better protect the people who matter most—our families, neighbors, and first responders. In Yuma County, we know the dangers of wildfire and flooding all too well. Empty, remove, cover or turn upside down any receptacle that would hold water — particularly old bottles and tin cans.

Change water and scrub vases holding flowers or cuttings twice each week — or grow cuttings in sand.

Discard old tires or store them indoors.

Screen rain barrels and openings to water tanks or cisterns.

Repair leaky plumbing and outside faucets

Connect open waste-water drains to a sewage system, or construct separate sump or leach lines

Clean clogged roof gutters and drain flat roofs.

Fill holes in trees with sand or mortar, or drain or spray them, as required

Stock ornamental ponds with mosquito fish
